Texts for Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours, Lectionary Entry

On January 25, 2021, Pope Francis ordered the inscription of Saint John of Avila, Priest and Doctor of the Church, into the General Roman Calendar. Saint John is to be celebrated each year as an Optional Memorial on May 10.

The proper liturgical texts were released by the Holy See in Latin. English and Spanish translations must be approved by the USCCB and confirmed by the Holy See before they can be implemented in the United States.
